



CLOVERDALE COUNTRY FAIR PRESENTS AGRI-SCIENCE FAIR FOR STUDENTS

Surrey, B.C.: B.C.'s most beloved annual exhibition will showcase bright young scientific minds in a brand new competition – the **Cloverdale Country Fair's Agri-Science Fair**.

Most often, agriculture is not the main focus in science fairs; however, by breaking out the magnifying glass one can see that many other fair's categories directly relate to the field. With Surrey's strong involvement in agriculture, the Agri-Science Fair will be an entertaining display of those agricultural related sciences, ones such as, botany, zoology, and chemistry.

The submissions are limited in number, so start dusting off the beaker and petri dish and explore the mysterious world of science in agriculture. The Agri-Science Fair will have two divisions: one, ages 10 to 13, and the second, ages 14 to 17. First, second, and third place prizes will be awarded in each division as follows: first, \$100, second, \$75, and third, \$50. Entries are due, May 2, 2008 by 4:30 PM.

Winning submissions will be unveiled to the public at the Cloverdale Country Fair, May 16 – 19, 2008.

The Cloverdale Rodeo and Exhibition Association is the non-profit organization that manages the world famous Cloverdale Rodeo & Country Fair held every year on the May long weekend (May 16 – 19, 2008) at the Cloverdale Fairgrounds in Surrey, British Columbia. The Association is also responsible for the year-round management of the eight facilities on the Cloverdale Fairgrounds that host over 1000 events annually, including trade shows, concerts, festivals, sporting events, horse and dog shows, swap meets, flea markets, weddings and meetings.
